FORREST T. LINTON MEMORIAL CLASSIC – Open to horses only. No restriction on Riders. Jump height 2'6" and 3', rider's choice. The class will consist of two rounds, with one set of ribbons awarded after the second round. The second round will be a Handy Hunter round and judged on promptness and handiness without affecting performance and style. The class will be judged as a hunter class. Each round will be given a numerical score. The first round will not have a posted jump order. The second round will be jumped in the order from lowest to highest first round score at each jump height. The horse with the highest cumulative points will win. Points will be awarded as 20, 12, 8, 4, 3, 2 and count toward the year-end awards for the Forrest T. Linton Memorial Classic. In addition, placing at this show will be the tie breaker for any year-end ties.

FORREST T. LINTON MEMORIAL PONY CLASSIC – Open to ponies only. Riders must be Juniors. Jump height 2' and 2'6", rider's choice. The class will consist of two rounds, with one set of ribbons awarded after the second round. The second round will be a Handy Hunter round and judged on promptness and handiness without affecting performance and style. To be conducted and judged the same as the Forrest T. Linton Memorial Classic. The pony with the highest cumulative points will win. Points will be awarded as 20, 12, 8, 4, 3, 2 and count toward the year-end awards for the Forrest T. Linton Memorial Pony Classic. In addition, placing at this show will be the tie breaker for any year-end ties.

EQUITATION ON THE FLAT – Juniors and Adult Amateurs to show at the walk, trot, canter. Judge may do additional tests. To be split Adult Amateurs, Juniors 15-17, Juniors 14 and under if entries warrant.

DIRECTIONS

From Northern VA: I-95 South to Exit 130B (Rt. 3 West). Go six traffic lights to left on Salem Church Road (Rt. 639). Continue to Harrison Road (Rt. 620). Turn left on Harrison Road. Go approximately 1 mile to Hazelwild Farm on left.

From Richmond: I-95 North to Exit 126. Take Rt. 1 north off Exit 126 to Rt. 620 (Harrison Road). Turn left on Harrison Road. Continue approximately 1 mile and cross over I-95. Hazelwild Farm is first turn on right.

From Southern MD: Take U.S. 301 South across Potomac River. Turn right on Rt. 206 towards King George. Turn right on Rt. 3 West. Continue about 30 miles to Rt. 1. Follow Rt. 1 south to Rt. 620 (Harrison Road). Turn right on Harrison Road. Go approximately 1 mile, cross over I-95. Farm is first right after overpass.

From Warrenton: Take 17 South to I-95 South. Go 1 exit to 130B. Follow Northern VA directions above.

From Culpeper: Take Rt. 3 East to Rt. 620 (Harrison Road). Turn right on Harrison Road. Continue approximately 4 miles to Hazelwild Farm on left.

DIVISION SPECIFICATIONS

Leadline - Open to riders 7 and under. Riders may not cross enter into any class where they would be asked to trot. To be judged 50% equitation and 50% suitability of mount.

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation - Open to riders 10 years and under. Judged on equitation. Riders may not cross enter into any classes in which they would be asked to canter or jump.

Short Stirrup Equitation - Open to riders 12 years and under. Judged on equitation. Riders may not cross enter into classes where they would jump over 18". Course may be trotted.

Student Equitation - Open to riders in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2' or higher. Judged on equitation. Course may be trotted.

Pleasure Pony - Open to ponies ridden by juniors. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going.

Pleasure Horse - Open to any horse. To be judged on manners, suitability, soundness, and way of going. To be split Adult Pleasure Horse and Jr. Pleasure Horse

BHSA Pony Equitation - Open to junior riders mounted on ponies. Fence heights: 2' for small ponies, 2'3" for medium ponies and 2'6" for large ponies. The judge may select at least 1/4 of the class to show at the walk, trot, and canter, and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion.

BHSA Children/Adult Amateur Equitation - Open to juniors and adult amateurs. Fence height choice of 2'6" or 3'. The judge may select at least 1/4 of the class to show at the walk, trot, and canter, and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion.

Green Pony Hunter - Open to ponies in their first year of showing at regulation heights. To be ridden by Juniors. Fence heights: 2' for small ponies, 2'3" for medium ponies and 2'6" for large ponies.

Maiden Hunter - Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing over fences at 2' or higher. No restrictions on Riders. Courses may be trotted. Fence height 2'.

Green Hunter - Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'6" or higher. Fence height 2'6".

Pony Hunter - Open to ponies ridden by juniors. The division will be split to small/medium and large ponies if entries warrant. Fence heights: 2' for small ponies, 2'3" medium ponies and 2'6" for large ponies.

Low Hunter - Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fence height 2'3".

Limit Rider Hunter - Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors and adult amateurs who are not entered in any classes jumping 2'6" or higher. These riders are not eligible for AA Equitation, Pony Equitation, or Jr./Children's Equitation. Ponies must be ridden by juniors. Horses and ponies may cross enter into other divisions. Courses to be a minimum of 6 fences set at 2'3".

Schooling Hunter - Open to horses and ponies. Adults may ride ponies not entered in a Pony Division. Fence height 2'6".

TB Hunter - Open to registered TBs and horses eligible to be registered. Fence height 2'6". No restriction on riders.

Children/Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to horses ridden by juniors and horses or ponies not entered in a Pony Division ridden by adult amateurs. Fence height choice of 2'6" or 3'. The division will be split if entries warrant.

Working Hunter - Open to all horses and ponies not entered in a Pony Division. Fence height 3'.

All Hunter classes judged on performance, including way of going, jumping style, and soundness. Manners and suitability emphasized in Pony, Children's and Adult Amateur.

All Equitation classes are judged on hands, seat, guidance and control.

SHOW RULES

1. ASTM/SEI Certified Helmets with harness fastened must be worn when mounted. Proper attire is required. Full chaps not permitted, leather half chaps that match paddock boots are allowed.
2. The Judge's decision is final.
3. BHSA points will be counted 20, 12, 8, 4, 2, 1. Champion will be counted as 10 additional points and Reserve Champion as 6 additional. Classic show points will count in addition to Top Ten Horse Shows for BHSA Members. FLC and FLPC points will be awarded as 20, 12, 8, 4, 3, 2. VHSA Points will be counted 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, .5
4. Entry Fees: Pre-entry is \$16.00 per class. Entries must be post marked by Thursday, 10/19/17 or on-line/e-mail entries by Wednesday, 10/25/17. Note: Checks do not need to be sent with the pre-entry form. Post-entry is \$20.00 per class.

6. Show management reserves the right to combine, cancel, or split classes; also to refuse any entry or to change officials. Flat classes will be held outside to expedite the show schedule.
7. No dogs allowed.
8. Refreshments available on grounds.
9. Lunging is permitted only in the ring near the entrance of the farm.
10. All exhibitors must present a hard copy of a negative Coggins Test taken within one year on each entry. This copy will be forwarded to the State per their request.
11. Limited day stalls available. Please call Hazelwild Farm at (540) 891-7101 to reserve.
12. The BHSA, its board of directors, and their officials and employees and the Hazelwild Farm Educational Foundation, Hazelwild Riding School, its board of directors, and their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, rider, guest, groom attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at the show. Any equine activity, sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. Entry onto the grounds constitutes knowledge and agreement with this policy.
13. Class Specifications: Every class offered herein, covered by the rules and regulations of the BHSA and VHSA Rule Books will be conducted and judged accordingly.
