

BHSA JUNIOR COMMITTEE GUIDELINES

The purpose of the BHSA Junior committee is to act as a liaison between the Junior members and the BHSA Board. The committee is to be made up of BHSA Junior members appointed by the BHSA Board President or designated Senior Chairman for the Junior Committee. Any Juniors wishing to serve on the committee must express their desire by completing the Junior Committee Application and submitting it along with a written reference to the BHSA President or designated Senior Chairman, who will decide upon their acceptance.

The Junior committee is not an independent body within the BHSA and has no authority to create its own rules, regulations, or procedures. In the past the person overseeing the Junior committee has been a Board member who acts as the Senior Chairman to the committee. Even if a Junior were to be elevated to a role such as Vice-Chairman he or she would still be under the leadership of the Senior Chairman.

The Junior Committee can make recommendations on activities, rules, shows, etc., but they must be made to and through their Senior Chairman. They cannot become independent actions of the Junior Committee.

The goals of the Junior Committee is to assist the BHSA with fundraising events, volunteering of services and present other ideas and opportunities that will help to make the association better for all its members.

Meetings of the committee may be called by the BHSA President or Senior Chairman of such committee.
