

For BHSA Points

Below are listed the Division combinations accepted by BHSA and the combinations accepted by VHSA and they are not necessarily the same. If eligible Divisions are combined, it is the show secretary's or show manager's responsibility to indicate on the results what Division(s) the points should be posted to.

BHSA HUNTER DIVISIONS THAT CAN BE COMBINED: For BHSA Points

- ❖ **Green Pony Hunter/Pony Hunter:** Can be combined, must jump their appropriate heights. If the Green Pony Hunter is combined with Pony Hunter then no other combination can be made.
- ❖ **Green Hunter/Green Pony Hunter/ Maiden Hunter:** Can be combined because all these divisions are based on the animal's first or second year of showing. If you combine the Maiden and Greens then the Maidens must canter in the under saddle class. Entries must jump their appropriate height. **(Combining Maidens with Greens is only legal for the BHSA. See Green Hunter/Green Pony Hunter under VHSA below).**
- ❖ **Green Hunter/Working Hunter/TB Hunter:** Can be combined but must jump their appropriate heights. Note: The Green Pony Hunter cannot be combined with Green Hunter if the Green Hunter is combined with the Working Hunter and/or TB Hunter. You either combine Green Pony with Green Hunter or Green Hunter with Working Hunter and/or TB Hunter.
- ❖ **Low/Schooling Hunter:** Can be combined because these divisions are open with no restrictions on the animal as long as they jump the appropriate height. **(Adults may ride ponies not entered in a Pony Division in Schooling or Working).**
- ❖ **Schooling/Working Hunter:** Can be combined because these divisions are open with no restrictions on the animal as long as they jump the appropriate height. **(Adults may ride ponies not entered in a Pony Division in Schooling or Working). (If combining the Working with the Schooling you must report the combined Division to VHSA as Working. See Schooling/Working Hunter under the VHSA below)**
- ❖ **Children's Hunter/Adult Amateur Hunter:** Can be combined because both these divisions have limitations on the rider. NOTE: In a desperate situation you can combine Pony Hunter with Children's or Adult Amateur due to the limitations on the rider as long as they all jump their appropriate height.
- ❖ **Student Equitation/Short Stirrup Equitation:** Can be combined because these divisions have limitations on the rider, but only if the division's classes match up (2 over fences and 1 hack or a walk/trot, walk/trot/canter and 1 over fences) and they jump their appropriate height.
- ❖ **Adult Pleasure Horse/Junior Pleasure Horse/Pleasure Pony:** All pleasure divisions can be combined.

BHSA/VHSA GUIDELINES**For VHSA Points**

The VHSA will not count points for its Divisions if combined with a BHSA Division that does not jump the height specified for the VHSA Division involved. If eligible Divisions are combined, it is the show secretary's responsibility to indicate on the results what Division(s) the points should be posted to.

BHSA /VHSA HUNTER DIVISIONS THAT CAN BE COMBINED: For VHSA Points

- ❖ **Green Pony Hunter/Pony Hunter:** Can be combined, must jump their appropriate heights. If the Green Pony Hunter is combined with Pony Hunter then no other combination can be made.
- ❖ **Green Hunter/Green Pony Hunter:** Can be combined because these divisions are based on the animal's first or second year of showing. Cannot be combined with Maiden Hunter because Maiden has jumps not set at VHSA Green Hunter height and it is not a VHSA division.
- ❖ **Green Hunter/Working Hunter/ TB Hunter :** : Can be combined but must jump their appropriate heights. Note: The Green Pony Hunter cannot be combined with Green Hunter if the Green Hunter is combined with the Working Hunter and/or TB Hunter. You either combine Green Pony with Green Hunter or Green Hunter with Working Hunter and/or TB Hunter.
- ❖ **Schooling/Working Hunter:** Can be combined because these two divisions are open with no restrictions on the animal and the minimum Schooling Hunter jump height is 2'6" which is the VHSA's minimum height for Working Hunter. **(Adults may ride ponies not entered in a Pony Division in Schooling or Working Hunter).** Remember, for BHSA

points all Working Hunter entries must jump at least 2'9". Cannot be combined with BHSA Low Hunter because the Low Hunter heights are 2' or 2'3".

- ❖ **Children's Hunter/Adult Amateur Hunter:** Can be combined because both these divisions have limitations on the rider and the jump heights are the same.
- ❖ **Adult Pleasure Horse/Junior Pleasure Horse/Pleasure Pony:** All pleasure divisions can be combined.
